INFORMATION SHEET

Transportation to Hatchlands Park

For reasons of convenience, the following method of transport to Hatchlands Park for the sessions on 23 April is recommended:

09.03 train from London Waterloo station (Platform 3, please check on day in case of any last minute changes)

09.48 train arrives at Horsley station, where a coach will transport all delegates to Hatchlands Park. Please note that there is only one coach – if you arrive on another train, you will need to arrange your own taxi etc.

18.20 train leaves Horsley station. The coach will take delegates from Hatchlands back to the station.

19.07 train arrives at London Waterloo.

Waterloo station is easily accessible via the tube network – from Baker Street, the Jubilee line or Bakerloo lines go directly to Waterloo in approximately 10 minutes.

It is recommended that rail tickets are purchased in advance at: <http://www.nationalrail.co.uk>.

There are, of course, alternative ways of getting to Hatchlands Park, e.g. by road. The address is: East Clandon, Guildford, Surrey, GU4 7RT. Please let us know in advance if you do not wish to take the coach.
